### **SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO BY INTERNET AUCTION**

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code, Section 317.12, the Board of Preble County Commissioners will use the method of internet auction to sell county personal property from the General Fund departments and the departments under the direction of the Preble County elected officials, including motor vehicles, road machinery, equipment, tools and supplies, that is not needed for public use, is obsolete, or unfit for the use for which it was acquired. The internet auction(s) of the county personal property will be conducted in the following manner:

1. All items to be sold via internet auction will be posted on the GovDeals.com website;
2. All items will be sold to the highest bidder unless a minimum price has been set that is not met;
3. All items will be available for bid for a minimum of ten (10) days, including weekends and holidays;
4. The auction will be conducted by the County with a contact person listed with each item or lot of items to be sold;
5. All items will be sold "As is, Where is";
6. The Board of Preble County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to withdraw from sale any items listed;
7. Payment is due not later than 5 business days after notice is sent of a successful bid;
8. All bidders must agree to the Online Sales – Terms & Conditions posted with the items on GovDeals.com website
